Australian Technology Park is host to a diverse community of science, communications and IT companies. Amidst its industrial architecture and innovative campus environment, the Park is also home to one of Australia's most unique conferencing and exhibition venues.

The Park exists on almost 14 hectares of campus featuring a unique integration of heritage architecture, premium commercial space and state-of-the-art conferencing facilities.

Conceived by a consortium of Sydney universities in 1993 ATPSL is now wholly-owned by the New South Wales Government's Redfern-Waterloo Authority.

Australian Technology Park works closely with the community and tenants including a Sustainability and Innovation Committee, a CEO Forum and community consultations.

MAKING A FORMAL APPLICATION

If you cannot find what you are looking for through an informal request, an application for formal access to ATP information under the *GIPA Act* can be made by lodging a formal Access Application Form, along with a \$30 application fee. Processing charges cost \$30 per hour after the first hour. An internal review of a reviewable decision costs \$40. A discount to the processing charge may apply in certain circumstances.
